Pronouns (Singular, Plural, Possessives)
A pronoun takes the place of a noun and refers to a person, place, thing, idea, feeling, or quality. A singular pronoun means that the pronoun refers to a singular noun. For example, one boy is *he*, one girl is *she*. A plural pronoun is a pronoun that talks about more than one noun. For example, two boys or girls have the pronoun *they*. Other plural pronouns are *our* and *their*. Possessive pronouns show ownership, or that something belongs to the pronoun. For example, the following sentences show possessive singular pronouns: *The ball is mine. That is my ball. The ball is his. The ball belongs to her.* The following sentences show possessive plural pronouns: *The ball is ours. This ball is yours. The ball is theirs.*




